



COVID-19 DRIVE-THRU TESTING OKALOOSA COUNTY

What do I need in order to be tested?

- No cost testing is now available to all community members with and without symptoms.
- Children can be tested with parent or legal guardian. Children must be able to complete the test without restraint.
- No appointment or pre-screening required.
- Please bring a government issued id.

What happens when I arrive at the testing site?

- Everyone will be asked to provide their first and last name, address, gender, date of birth, race, ethnicity, address, county of FL residency, and a working phone number.
- All passengers must stay inside vehicles from arrival to departure.
- Limit the people in your personal vehicle to a maximum of five to be tested.

How will I receive my results?

- After being tested, continue to monitor and record symptoms.
- You will receive your test results via telephone call.



What else do I need to know?

- Antibody testing is NOT available at these test sites.
