## **Welcome!**

We are ready to begin another season in baseball and softball. We will begin the season in March to enable us to end near the time the school year ends.

## **League Ages**

Age attained prior to May 1, 2012.

## **Baseball**

T-Ball	5-6 yr. olds.
Coach Pitch	7-8 yr. olds.
Minor Majors	9-10 yr. olds.
Little Majors	11-12 yr. olds.
Junior Majors	13-15 yr. olds.

## **Girl's Softball**

Coach Pitch	7-9 yr. olds.
Juniors Softball	10-12 yr. olds.
Senior Softball	13-15 yr. olds.

## **Registration Cost**

If you live in the City limits: \$60.  
If you live outside the City limits: \$65.

The registration fee will include the cost of a shirt, pants, and a cap which the players will keep at season's end.

**Please be very careful as you select sizes. The uniform will be ordered in accordance with your instructions. Lost or damaged uniforms will be the responsibility of the player.**

## **Equipment Policy**

Issued equipment must be returned following the last game of the season.

## **Opening Day**

Games will begin on Monday, March 12, 2012. Not all teams will play on this date.

**Games will not be scheduled from Monday, March 19 through Friday, March 23 for Spring Break Holidays.**

**We will play the Saturday at the beginning of Spring Break and the Saturday at the end of Spring Break.**

You **may not** re-enter the draft **and** file an exclusion form, if your child is returning to the previous year division.

## **Team Placement**

Your child will be placed on their team based upon age, previous year's team or through the draft. The only exception to this system will be in a case where health is a consideration. The transportation of your child to practices and games is your responsibility. **There will be no special requests.**

## **Player Participation**

Each player is guaranteed to play three innings or forty-five minutes in each game. Players must attend practices to remain eligible for play. Please keep the coach informed of problems which might keep a player from regularly attending practices or games.

## **Uniform Policy**

**Uniforms shall be worn as issued.** The only exceptions to this policy will be in the case of; a sizing issue, loss or damage. The replacement shirt/jersey or pants/shorts shall be comparable in style and color to the originally issued uniform item. For example: Solid gray pants for baseball and softball, solid black shorts for basketball and soccer (no pockets, belt loops, stripes or large logos). Shirts/jersey's shall be of like style and color. If the replacement item is questionable, please contact the Parks and Recreation office for approval.

## **Post Season Tournaments**

All star teams in some divisions will be involved in post season tournament play. Coaches will vote to select players for these teams. **Players will be notified individually after all awards ceremonies have been concluded.**

## **Awards**

Each player will receive a medal at a post season awards ceremony. The first place team will receive gold medals, second place team will receive silver medals, and all other players will receive bronze medals.

## **Pre-season Coach's Meeting**

**A coach's meeting will be held at 6:00 pm on Wednesday, February 22, 2012** at the Sr. Center at Spanish Trail Park on Stillwell Blvd. All information needed for the draft will be available as well as discussion regarding rules and league policies.
