WELCOME!

We are looking forward to the return of baseball, softball and T-ball in Crestview. The season begins in April. Our goal is to end the season close to the end of the school year.

LEAGUE AGES

Age attained prior to May 1, 2022. Participants' birth certificates are required at time of registration.

BASEBALL:

- T-Ball (coed:) 5-6 yr. olds.
- Coach Pitch: 7-8 yr. olds.
- Minor Majors: 9-10 yr. olds.
- Little Majors: 11-12 yr. olds.
- Junior Majors: 13-15 yr. olds.

GIRL'S SOFTBALL:

- Coach Pitch: 7-9 yr. olds.
- Juniors Softball: 10-12 yr. olds.
- Senior Softball: 13-15 yr. olds.

REGISTRATION FEES

- If you live within the Crestview city limits: \$60
- If you live outside the city limits: \$65

The registration fee includes a shirt and a cap which the players will keep at season's end. Please be very careful as you select sizes. The uniform will be ordered in accordance with your instructions. Replacement of lost or damaged uniforms will be the responsibility of the player.

OPENING DAY

Games will begin on Monday, April 4, 2022. Not all teams will play on this date. Each coach will be issued a schedule listing all of the teams' games for the season. Each team is guaranteed a 10-game season.

TEAM PLACEMENT

Your child will be placed on a team based upon age, previous year's team or through the draft. The only exception to this system is where health is a consideration. The transportation of your child to practices and games is your responsibility. There will be no special requests. League and team sizes are subject to final registration numbers.

DRAFT SCHEDULE

The draft will be at Spanish Trail Park on the following dates/times:

BASEBALL DRAFTS

- Coach Pitch Boys: 2 p.m., Saturday, March 5
- Minor Majors: 8 a.m., Saturday, March 5
- Little Majors: 11 a.m., Saturday, March 5
- Junior Majors: 5:30 p.m., Monday, March 7

SOFTBALL DRAFTS

- Coach Pitch, Girls: 5:30 p.m., Tuesday, March 8
- Junior Softball: 5:30 p.m., Thursday, March 10
- Senior Softball: TBD

The Coach Exclusion Form (yellow sheet) will not be allowed the day of the draft. The form must be completed and returned to the Parks and Recreation office in the Twin Hills Park gymnasium by close of business the day prior to the draft. You may not re-enter the draft and file an exclusion form if your child is returning to the previous year division.

UNIFORM POLICY

Uniforms shall be worn as issued. The only exceptions to this policy will be in the case of a sizing issue, or loss or damage. The replacement shirt/jersey shall be comparable in style and color to the originally issued uniform item. If the replacement item is questionable, please contact Parks and Recreation office for approval.

AWARDS

Trophies will be distributed by the coaches. All T-ball players will receive a trophy. First- and second-place teams in the other divisions will receive individual trophies.

PLAYER PARTICIPATION

Each player is guaranteed to play three innings or 45 minutes in each game. However, players must attend practices to remain eligible for play. If two practices in a row are missed without explanation, a player may be benched for one game. Please keep the coach informed of situations that might keep a player from regularly attending practices or games.

EQUIPMENT POLICY

Issued equipment must be returned following the last game of the season.

COACHES

The selection of coaches for teams is one of the most important duties of the league. Our coaches work on a volunteer basis and receive no payment for their dedication and efforts. Your support is welcomed and appreciated during the season. Keep in mind the only difference between you as a parent and your child's coach is that the coach is able to make time available to conduct practices and coach during the games.

PRE-SEASON COACH'S MEETING

A coach's meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 2, 2022, at Warriors Hall, Whitehurst Municipal Building, 201 Stilwell Blvd. All information regarding the draft, rules and league policies will be presented.

CONDUCT POLICY
